- 97) Proverbs 21: 23 – He who guards his mouth and his tongue keeps himself from calamity.**
- 98) Proverbs 22:1 – A good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold.**

- 101) John 1:1 - In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.**
- 102) John 1:2 - He was with God in the beginning.**
- 103) John 1:3 - Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.**
- 104) John 1:4 - In him was life, and that life was the light of men.**
- 105) John 1:5 - The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it.**
- 106) John 3:5 - Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit"**
- 107) John 3:6 - Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.**
- 108) John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.**
- 109) John 3:17 - For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.**

- 112) John 3:36 - Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him**
- 113) John 4:24 - God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.**
- 114) John 4:34 - My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work"**

- 133) John 12:8 - You will always have the poor among you, but you will not always have me."**
